Dear Families,

The following is a list of supplies that you should send with your child:

- 2 Boxes of #2 pencils, with erasers (12 in a box)
- 5 Erasers
- 1 Pair of scissors (blunt tip)
- 10 White glue sticks
- 1 Package of white photocopy paper (heavy weight)
- 1 Package construction paper (multicolor)
- 3 Drawing pads (8 ½ x 13 corsario brand – 2 for class and 1 for Spanish)
- 1 Pocket folders (for weekly papers) (9x12)
- 1 Bottle instant hand sanitizer (small or medium size)
- 1 Box of kleenex
- 1 Package of baby wipes
- 1 Box gallon size zip lock bags
- 1 Box quart/sandwich size zip lock bags
- 4 Tennis balls
- 1 Lunch box
- 1 Backpack
- 2 Dry erase markers
- 1 Box of crayons (24 or more) or colored pencil
- 1 Sock for erasing (old sock will do, sport socks are best)
- \$20 for extra activities (Please send in an envelope with your child's name on it.)
- 1 Change of clothes to keep at school

DO NOT PURCHASE A CALCULATOR
